## Unit of Competency TLID2010A Operate a Forklift

### Who is the course designed for?

Generally this course is usually offered for existing forklift operators requiring a refresher course. Trainees must possess an LF class High Risk Work Photo Licence.

This course is designed for participants in various retail, wholesale, warehousing construction, farming etc. Completion of this qualification no longer is used for licencing. Participants must hold a valid LF class High Risk Work Licence.

The course provides a pathway leading onto a full qualification in Transport and Logistics (TLI10).

Students can contact the state or territory licencing authority for qualification criteria and advice. The contact phone number for SafeWork NSW (previously WorkCover NSW) is 131050.

### How are students assessed?

Students will undergo a theory and practical test.

The theory test requires the completion of 36 written questions within 30 minutes. It is a closed book test and no outside assistance is allowed. Groups can sit for the test at one time providing there is sufficient separation. A practical driving test is asked of you where you must demonstrate knowledge on pre-start checks, hazard control, shifting of loads and the safe shut down and securing of a forklift. The driving test should last approximately 30 minutes, but you are allowed one hour to complete the assessment.

If a student has problems with written English the theory test may be given orally, but arrangements must be made at time of booking.

## Checklist for clients prior to assessments

### Compliant Forklift and Assessment Area (if conduct on-site).

- 🍏 Forklift is in safe operating condition and complies with the requirements of the state or territory legislation where the training is being conducted.
- 🍏 You have the ability to stack loads to low, medium and full lift height of the forklift. i.e. pallet racking or block stacking.
- 🍏 You will need to ensure that sufficient space is available for manoeuvring. It is important that loads are available that are would normally be handled in the workplace.

### Individual Requirements

- 🍏 Students must be over 18 years old and possess a valid LF class High Risk Work forklift license.
- 🍏 The High Risk Work LF license must be sighted by the trainer at commencement of the course.
- 🍏 PPE appropriate to your work site (or if at the training centre long sleeve shirt, pants and your work boots) must be worn at all times.
