

Pre-enrolment course conditions

Nationally Recognised Training Courses

Before deciding to enrol in this course there are some criteria you must be aware of.

Course requirements

Unique Student Identifier (USI) - To be able to complete this course it is now a legal requirement that you provide your USI. More information about the USI can be found at www.usi.gov.au. You can also create your USI at this website.

Language Literacy and Numeracy – It is a Government requirement that you must be able to complete the knowledge assessment in English. If you have any concerns with reading or writing English to a reasonable standard, please let us know asap. There are support options available.

Identification – You will have to provide some form of photo identification.

Student Visa – If you are in Australia on a Student Visa it is illegal to undertake any VET training other than with a CRICOS provider. We cannot enrol you in this course.

Pre-work - You may be required to complete some pre-work before the course. If so this must be brought with you on the first day.

Attendance - You will be required to attend the whole course time. There are no sections that can be missed.

Do you have existing skills and knowledge in this field? If so and it is recent you may be able to apply for recognised prior learning for part or all of the training. You will need to provide evidence if such.

High Risk Work Licence: Most of the nationally Recognised Training courses Forkpro Australia runs involve use of load shifting equipment. Some of these such as forklift and order picker require a High Risk Work Licence. You must hold a valid HRW licence for this class of equipment if it is to be used within the course.

Preparation for the course:

- You must wear closed in footwear, long pants and preferably long sleeved shirt.
- Bring driving/reading glasses if required
- You must not be under the influence of any drug or alcohol
- You will need to be well rested.
