Course requirements:

- Age You must be minimum of 18 years of age.
- Unique Student Identifier (USI) you must provide your Unique Student Identifier (see <u>www.usi.gov.au</u>).
- Language, Literacy, Numeracy & Digital Proficiency you require English reading, writing & numeracy skills that enables the safe performance of high risk work as well as basic digital skills to undertake the enrolment process. There are support options available.
- Identification it is a legal requirement that Proof of Identity (POI) can be produced (see ID requirements sheet that accompanies this pack).
- **Student Visa holder** please advise us prior to enrolling if you hold a Student Visa (subclass 500 series), your VISA conditions may restrict your ability to complete this training course.
- Attendance you will be required to attend the whole course time. There are no sections that can be missed.
- Have you ever driven any vehicle before? if you have never driven a vehicle of any type before it may be difficult to obtain those base skills in the allocated course time. Please let us know and we can work out a plan to suit your needs.
- **PPE** you must wear a long sleeved shirt, long pants and closed in shoes
- Service NSW Account (NSW only) if you are completing your High Risk Work Licence assessment in NSW, you must have a Service NSW account to enrol into the assessment.

Please do not enrol until you are satisfied that you can meet all the requirements.
